

Tucson Country Day School
Second Quarter Schooling Plans
October 19th - December 17th

Parent Survey:

- 33% of families chose to have their students learn remotely, full-time.
- 67% of families chose blended learning, part-time on campus and part-time remote.

Remote Learning:

- *K - 5th Grade*
 - Students learning remotely will be placed in a cohort with remote learning peers and receive instruction in small groups.
 - Students will receive daily instruction from their first quarter teachers.
 - A new weekly schedule will be provided to students and families the week of October 5th.
- *6th - 8th Grade*
 - Students will continue to follow their first quarter schedule, receiving instruction from their same teachers within their same cohort. Instruction will be provided to both remote learners and on-campus learners at the same time by their teacher who will be on campus.

Blended Learning:

- *K - 5th Grade*
 - Students will attend classes on campus four days a week (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday). Wednesday will be a remote learning day.
 - Kinder and 1st grade students will be placed in one of three on-campus cohorts and will be assigned one teacher.
 - 2nd - 5th grade students will be placed in one of four on-campus cohorts and will receive instruction from four of their first quarter teachers throughout the week. Students will rotate to their teachers' classrooms for each subject with their assigned cohort.
 - On-campus learning will be in-person and teacher-led. Classrooms will be sanitized following each class.
- *6th - 8th Grade*
 - Students will attend classes on campus two days a week and attend remotely three days a week.
 - Sixth and eighth grade students will be on campus Monday and Friday. Seventh grade students will be on campus Tuesday and Thursday. Wednesdays will be remote learning for all middle school students.
 - Students will stay in their first quarter cohorts and follow their first quarter schedule, attending classes remotely and on-campus at the same times listed on their schedule.

- Students will rotate to their different teachers' classrooms for each subject. On-campus learning will be in-person and teacher-led. Classrooms will be sanitized following each class.
- *AM student drop-off times*
 - K/1st: 7:30-7:45
 - 2nd/3rd: 7:45-8:00
 - 4th/5th: 8:00-8:15
 - 6th-8th: 8:15-8:30
 - Siblings may be dropped off at the same time and will be placed in Sibling Care
 - There will be no AM Champion Care (before school)
- *PM student pick-up times*
 - K/1st: 2:15-2:30
 - 2nd/3rd: 2:30-2:45
 - 4th/5th: 2:45-3:00
 - 6th-8th: 3:00-3:15
 - For families with multiple attending students, free Sibling Care will be provided to allow parents to pick up all of their children within the time range of their oldest child.
 - PM Champion Care (aftercare) will be provided from 2:15-6:00. This service is fee-based.
 - Students not picked up within their assigned time listed above will be signed into PM Champion Care, and families will be charged accordingly.
